Turing test?

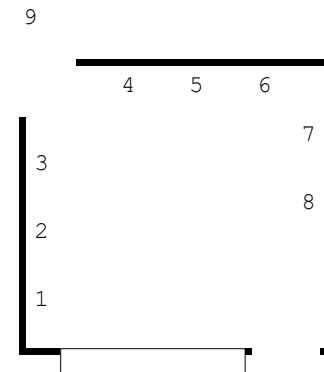
Monk: What makes us human?
